Importance of Information security compliance in modern day business

Organizations that handle sensitive data may become the subject of cyberattacks as criminals try to obtain that information for their own advantage. Malware, ransomware, social engineering attacks, and Denial of Service (DoS) attacks are frequent dangers that cost businesses money, time, and resources.

A report by IBM and the Ponemon institute found that the average cost of a corporate data breach has reached \$4.35 million in 2022, highlighting the importance of information security compliance.

For example- In August 2020, Lifespan Health System Affiliated Covered Entity, also known as Lifespan ACE, paid \$1,040,000 to the Office of Civil Rights due to a HIPAA violation as a result of the theft of an unencrypted laptop. As reported in Becker's Hospital Review, Lifespan notified patients on April 21, 2017 about the breach which occurred when a Lifespan employee's car was broken into on



February 25th. Several items were stolen, including a MacBook laptop the employee used for work purposes. A Lifespan internal investigation found the stolen laptop was unencrypted and not password protected, meaning the employee's work emails were potentially accessible.

But is cost the only motivating factor for companies to have better Information security compliance and data protection?

No, apart from the cost Let's look at why information security compliance is more important than ever for modern businesses:

- 1- It helps to avoid legal troubles, fines, and penalties from data breaches.
- 2- It protects sensitive client data, which helps in building customer trust, acquiring new clients, and enhancing the organization's reputation.
- 3- It enhances organization Data Management Capabilities.
- 4- It helps meet various industry standards requirements, and regulatory frameworks.
- 5- It helps fend off threats from competitors.

Information security compliance helps businesses implement robust security measures such as access controls, encryption, regular vulnerability assessments, and incident response plans to minimize the risk of data breaches and unauthorized access to sensitive information. The purpose of information security compliance is to ensure that organizations follow established policies, standards, and regulations to protect sensitive information and maintain the integrity, confidentiality, and availability of organization's data. In addition, it also keeps its operations legitimate, which ultimately impacts the organization's profits.

How can companies ensure information security compliance?

A report by PwC found that 85% of customers said they will not do business with a company if they are worried about its data practices and security compliance, businesses need to be proactive when it comes to information security. Ensuring information security compliance is necessary, and there are some measures companies can put in place to help.

Companies seeking greater information security compliance should:

- Limit access to valuable data to senior management.
- Vet and ensure that third parties comply with your data practices.
- Train and educate staff on the Cybersecurity and safe internet habits for maximum security.
- Improve digital hygiene through security audits.
- Seek out and put an end to unauthorized data sharing.
- Create a contingency plan of action in the event of a data breach.
